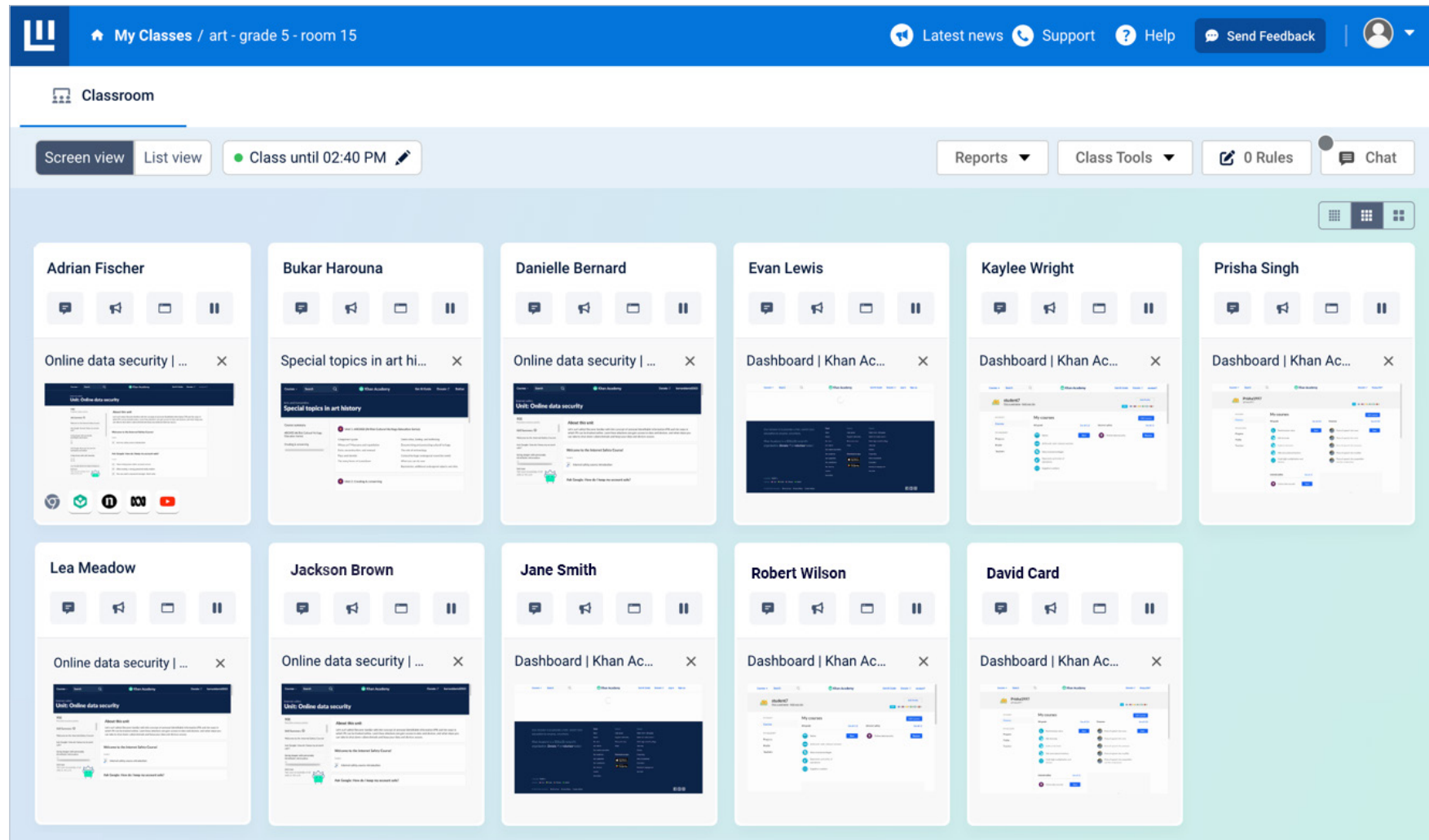

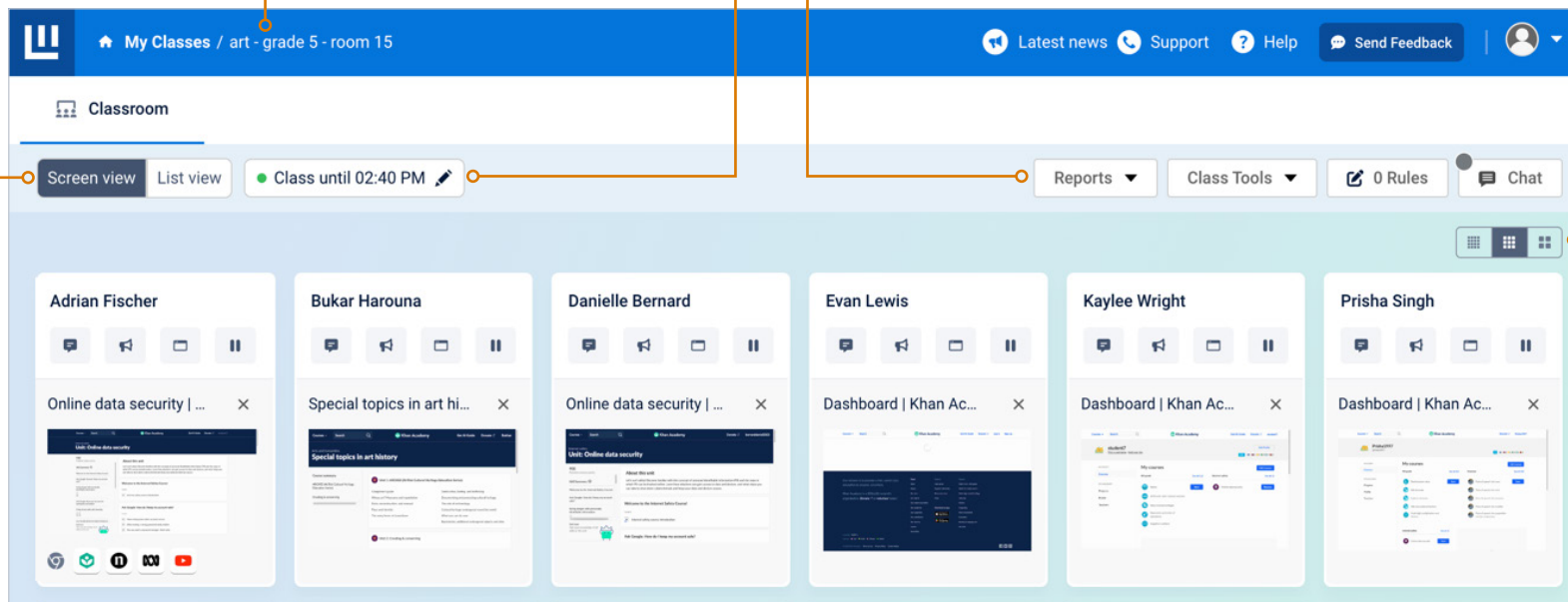

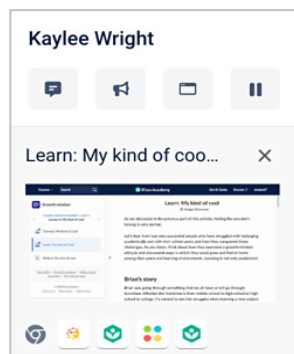

### VIEW FORMAT

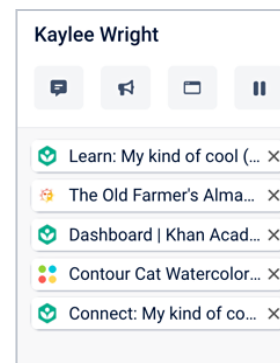
Displays the sites and apps that are open on a student's device. Toggle between a thumbnail image of the students' devices (Screen View) and the names of tabs or windows (List View).

In **Connect for Chrome**, select to see a list of the open tabs. Click the X to close a tab.

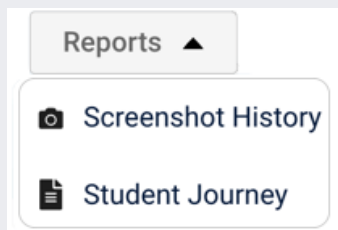
In **Connect for Windows** or **macOS**, select the title to open the activity in Live View.

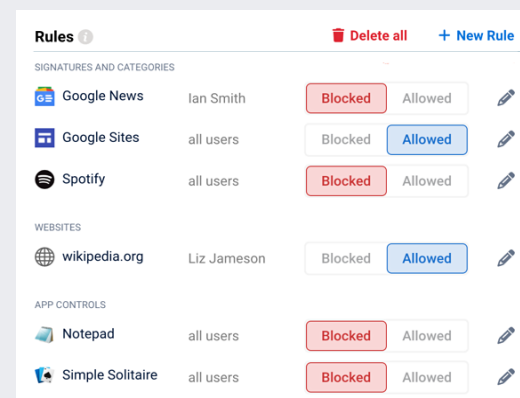

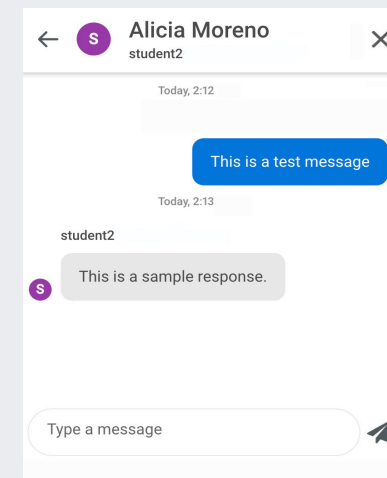

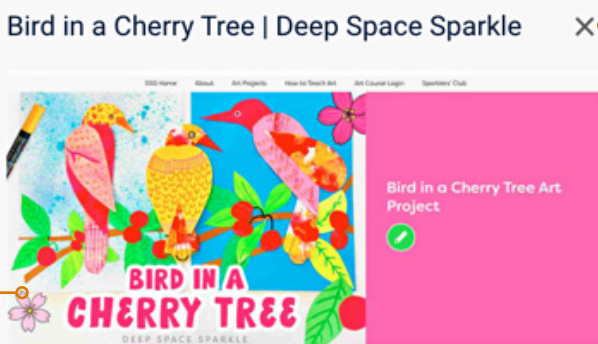
