Members of the committee were provided information regarding their roles and responsibilities via board policies BQA (LEGAL) and BQA (LOCAL). The following information was provided to the committee:

Regarding the AEIS report, PGISD was rated *Recognized*, PG Elementary was rated *Exemplary*, PG Middle School was rated *Exemplary*, and PG High School was rated *Academically Acceptable*. A public hearing regarding the AEIS report will be conducted on February 10 at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees.

Regarding AYP, the district and all campuses met AYP. Additionally, it was reported that all staff “met Highly Qualified” status.

Pleasant Grove ISD for the school year 2008-09 was assigned “Superior Achievement” for the FIRST (Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas). The School FIRST rating is assigned by the Texas Education Agency and is based on the school district’s overall performance on certain financial measurements, ratios, and other indicators.

Bill Harp discussed the recommendations submitted by the PGHS CIC regarding the Optional Flexible Year Program. The program allows districts to modify the instructional calendar. The HS CIC would like to increase the number of program days to 10 days and split them into two separate instructional periods. The current practice is 4 days at the end of the school year.
