Board policy BQA (LOCAL) was reviewed by committee members, which explains the purpose and responsibilities of the DEIC Committee. The following information was provided to the committee:

- 2011 Academic Excellence Indicator System Report
- Final 2011 Adequate Yearly Progress Results
- Information regarding Staffing Reductions for 2011-2012
- Budget Update
- Drafts of 2012-2013 school calendar

Regarding the AEIS report, the elementary school is rated *Exemplary*, the intermediate school is rated *Exemplary*, the middle school is rated *Exemplary*, the high school is rated *Academically Acceptable*, and the district earned a *Recognized* rating. In addition, the district earned a total of 21 *Gold Performance Acknowledgements*.

A review of the AYP report indicates that the district and all campuses met AYP.

As of February 6, 2012 the total loss of state funds for Pleasant Grove ISD is \$1,237,815. In addition, the district's appropriations from all categories of the general fund decreased by \$1,235,121. For the 2012-2013 school year, it is anticipated that there will be an additional loss of \$650,000 in state/federal funds.

Drafts of the 2012-2013 school calendar were provided. DEIC members were asked to bring back suggestions for the next meeting of the DEIC, which is scheduled for March 5, 2012.
