

INFORMATION LETTER FOR PARENTS 2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR

Dear Parents:

Supplemental student accident insurance is available for your purchase through **Texas Monarch Management**.

- ✓ **“At-School”** coverage provides protection for students during the regular school session for the school year.
- ✓ **“24-Hour”** coverage (“Around-the Clock”), protects students 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, anywhere accidents might happen, anywhere in the world.

This coverage provides protection from the date of enrollment (including summer months), until the start of the next school year. The premium (cost) of either of these optional coverages are paid “one-time only” for the year (annual payment). Please disregard senior high football premiums shown on the enclosed material, as the District pays for this option for your student. The District also covers all students in interscholastic sports and non-sport UIL activities for grades 7-12. The school policy provides limited benefits on an excess basis, meaning that benefits will be paid for covered expenses incurred after your primary insurance has either paid or denied benefits. **If you do not have personal insurance coverage for a covered accident, this insurance will act as the primary coverage.**

If you choose to purchase this coverage please go on-line to purchase. This coverage is available by credit card purchase “on-line” at HYPERLINK "<http://www.mmc-ins.com>" www.mmc-ins.com. When enrolling on-line, the coverage will be effective 24 hours after received by the Company. You can enroll from mobile devices (phone, iPad, etc.) or computer.
