

# Pleasant Grove Independent School District Board Goals and Plans Updated July 2022



## Goal Requirements:

- One annual goal in early childhood literacy aligned to 3rd grade STAAR results, one in early childhood math aligned to 3rd grade STAAR results, and one in CCMR aligned to graduates that meet readiness requirements
- Each goal needs to have one to three progress measures predictive to the goal
- Annual goals for students in each group evaluated under closing the gaps domain (25 or more students in a group)
- Targeted professional development for classroom teachers in kindergarten through 3rd grade for campuses that the board identifies as not meeting the plan's goals and that considers the unique needs of students in bilingual education or special language programs
- Annual goals must contain a baseline, target, population, and deadline month and year

Annual targets must be included for each goal in addition to the 5 year deadline target

## Board Outcome Goal 1: Early Childhood Literacy

The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 57% to 100% by June 2025.

## Targeted Professional Development

Targeted Professional Development for classroom teachers in kindergarten through 3rd grade includes:

- ❑ Early Childhood Literacy - Texas Education Agency requires each teacher and principal in kindergarten through 3rd grade to attend Reading Academies. Pleasant Grove ISD kindergarten through 3rd grade reading teachers will complete the academy during the 2021-2022 school year. All remaining kindergarten through 3rd grade teachers will complete the academy during the 2022-2023 school year. New staff will enroll and complete during Year 1.
- ❑ Early Childhood Math and College, Career, and Military Readiness - Teachers will regularly engage in job-embedded, ongoing professional learning through the Professional Learning Community model. Content area training will be provided based on grade level/content area needs.
